We are excited that you have a genuine interest in serving as a volunteer for the Exodus Mandate Project ministry. Exodus Mandate is a Christian project of Frontline Ministries, Inc.

THE MISSION

To encourage and assist Christian families to leave "Pharaoh's" school system (i.e., government schools) for the "Promised Land" of Christian schools or home schooling.

Before you decide what level of commitment you are willing to take, educate yourself about the dangers of government-sponsored education at the K-12 level. Visit our website www.exodusmandate.org and also our Facebook page, Exodus Mandate Community. Also, a variety of materials can be requested from the ministry.

STAGES OF INVOLVEMENT

There are several ways that you can serve, depending on the time and effort you can commit to:

- Layperson
- State or area coordinator
- C.E.R.T. Leader/member

LAYPERSON

- Prayer for the ministry; families, pastors and churches in your community on an on-going basis.
- 2. Share your concerns with your family, friends and pastor. Discuss with them the urgent need for Christians to remove their children from government schools.
- 3. <u>Distribute</u> brochures, DVDs, CDs, books and other materials that communicates the Exodus Mandate vision.

STATE OR AREA COORDINATOR

Prepared to donate 2-3 hours (or more) per week on our behalf. You should be a born-again believer; a member, in good standing, of an evangelical, orthodox church. In addition to doing what the layperson does, is a more refined list for coordinators:

Speak at churches, conventions, special meetings, debates and panel discussions;

Manning a booth and/or table at homeschool conferences, Christian school events;

Showing the "IndoctriNation" or "Escaping Common Core" DVDs in churches, Sunday School classes, Bible study groups, homeschool groups, public library, etc.;

Schedule radio, t.v. or media interviews;

<u>Compose</u> letters to the editor, comment on Facebook articles; We highly suggest starting your own Facebook or Wordpress page (i.e., Exodus Mandate Florida), posting articles from the main EM Facebook page, local homeschool and Christian school events, etc.; <u>Place</u> signs, bumper stickers in public places; <u>Leave</u> literature/brochures in places of businesses that you frequent;

Compile a list of homeschool families or groups from your state for future reference; Visit pastors in your area and discuss Christian education with them – see if they would be willing to add Exodus Mandate to their budgets for giving; Meet with Christian businesses and see if they would be willing to help financially (Possibly starting a student scholarship to a Christian school, or funding for a homeschool family or group); Represent the ministry with public officials, media and major Christian leaders; Help start a Christian school; Watch www.RayMooreLive.com every week, and share it with your network of friends and family; Recruit volunteers for the ministry who would work under your supervision.

C.E.R.T. LEADER/MEMBER

Christian Education Renewal Team (CERT). CERT is a basic grassroots team formed to implement the vision of Exodus Mandate. Organize a CERT in your community with as few as 2-3 Christians. Ideally, CERTs should have a diversified membership of 3-7 members, including a pastor and an educator. The CERT should remain an orthodox, interdenominational, evangelical Christian group. CERT is not a committee or a study group, but it is an action team and should meet regularly for prayer. Team members should become involved in their community, working to brief, inform, train and encourage the general atlarge Christian community to remove their children from government schools and to provide for them a Christian education. You can do this

- Showing "IndoctriNation" and "Escaping Common Core" DVDs;
- Distributing materials, articles that encourage the *exodus* out of government schools;
- Arranging meetings with Christian educators, businesses, leaders and show the DVDs. Invite discussions on the education crisis and how Christians should respond;
- Supporting existing Christian education alternatives in the community, assist in creating additional opportunities;
- See State Coordinator list for more suggestions.

The most IMPORTANT activity that EVERYONE can do is PRAY! For Christian parents who are faithfully seeking to honor the Lord in the education of their children and for those who continue to sacrifice their children's minds and hearts on the altar of public education. Pray that these parents will realize their error and remove their precious children.

OTHER SUGGESTIONS

- Start a homeschool co-op. Open your church for homeschooling families to meet for instruction, special activities, outreach opportunities.
- Hold Fundraising events: Car Wash, Yard Sales, Silent Auction; Bake/Craft Sales; Banquets, etc. Proceeds could go towards: Homeschool Field Trips; Student Scholarships (Adopt a student who needs tuition assistance to attend Christian school); tutoring assistance; financing a billboard with a Christian education message; ordering DVDs/books from Exodus Mandate to share; the possibilities are endless!
- Large Christian schools can start a satellite Christian school.
- Host an event bringing homeschool and Christian school students together for a common cause, project/activity.
- Invite a Christian author for a book signing event.
